Funding PM research- a pathway for its implementation

- Funding research and innovation in PM field- a key factor to ensure the development and implementation of PM.
- > Background: ERA PerMed- ERA-Net on Personalised Medicine.
- ➤ Different **Joint Funding Activities** could be developed in EP PerMed:
 - ✓ Transnational, multidisciplinary research funding calls,
 - ✓ Networking calls,
 - ✓ Research Innovation and Technology Calls



ERA PerMed- ERA-Net on Personalised Medicine

- ✓ Time frame: 6 years (Dec 2017 Nov 2023)
- ✓ Consortium: 32 funding organisations from 23 countries

32 partners

23 countries

19 EU countries
3 H2020 associated countries
(Israel, Norway, Turkey)
1 third country: Canada



EP PerMed- Funding PM opportunities

- > Supporting the PM science base through development of a coordinated approach to research and innovation.
- Common PM Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA) to align research priorities with the needs of different health systems.
- Promote the investigation of **potential benefits of PM** approaches to citizens and healthcare systems.
- Direct funding of PM research and innovation over the full value chain and covering all key areas of PM.
- Involving all funders and stakeholders and motivate national and regional funding agencies to launch local investments in PM.



Transnational and multidisciplinary research funding calls

- Promote PM research and foster innovation.
- Support multidisciplinary research projects in PM field.
- > Promote excellence in peer-reviewed transnational calls.
- Allow access to infrastructures, databases, platforms...
- Develop new and maintain existing transnational collaborations, including non-European countries.
- National / regional coordinated efforts and synergies.
- Annual calls to ensure continuous funding.



Transnational and multidisciplinary research funding calls

- > ERA-Net like calls launched annually (based on ERA PerMed).
- Up to three EC co-funded Joint Transnational Calls.
- > 3-year long multidisciplinary research projects.
- 2-staged and peer-reviewed transnational calls.
- > Flexibility, Scientific committee consultation for call scopes.
- Additionally non-cofunded JTCs or smaller multilateral calls.
- ➤ **FUNDERS**: Members and partners of EP PerMed, other interested funders.
- Virtual "common pot"

Networking calls

- Multidisciplinary new collaborations to promote PM knowledge sharing among PM key players with different geographic and research origin.
- > 1-2 years funding period.
- Expertise clusters to develop guidelines, documents, white papers, best practices and recommendations.
- Identification of critical aspects and those potential solutions that could ensure PM implementation and knowledge transfer to reach the market.
- Innovative collaborations to bridge the gap from research to marketaccess.
- ➤ **FUNDERS**: Members and partners of EP PerMed. Participation from EU13 countries or other underrepresented countries will be encouraged.

Research Innovation and Technology Calls

- ➤ Connecting experts from different PM fields to develop high-TRL innovative PM solutions.
- ➤ Outcome: innovation projects towards **starts-ups funding** and commercially viable **products and services**, ready for their translation to the **market**.
- > Scale-up local pilots up to interregional or transnational level.
- FUNDERS: regional and national funders interested in startup funding and high TRL. Seeking the participation of industry as funding partners.
